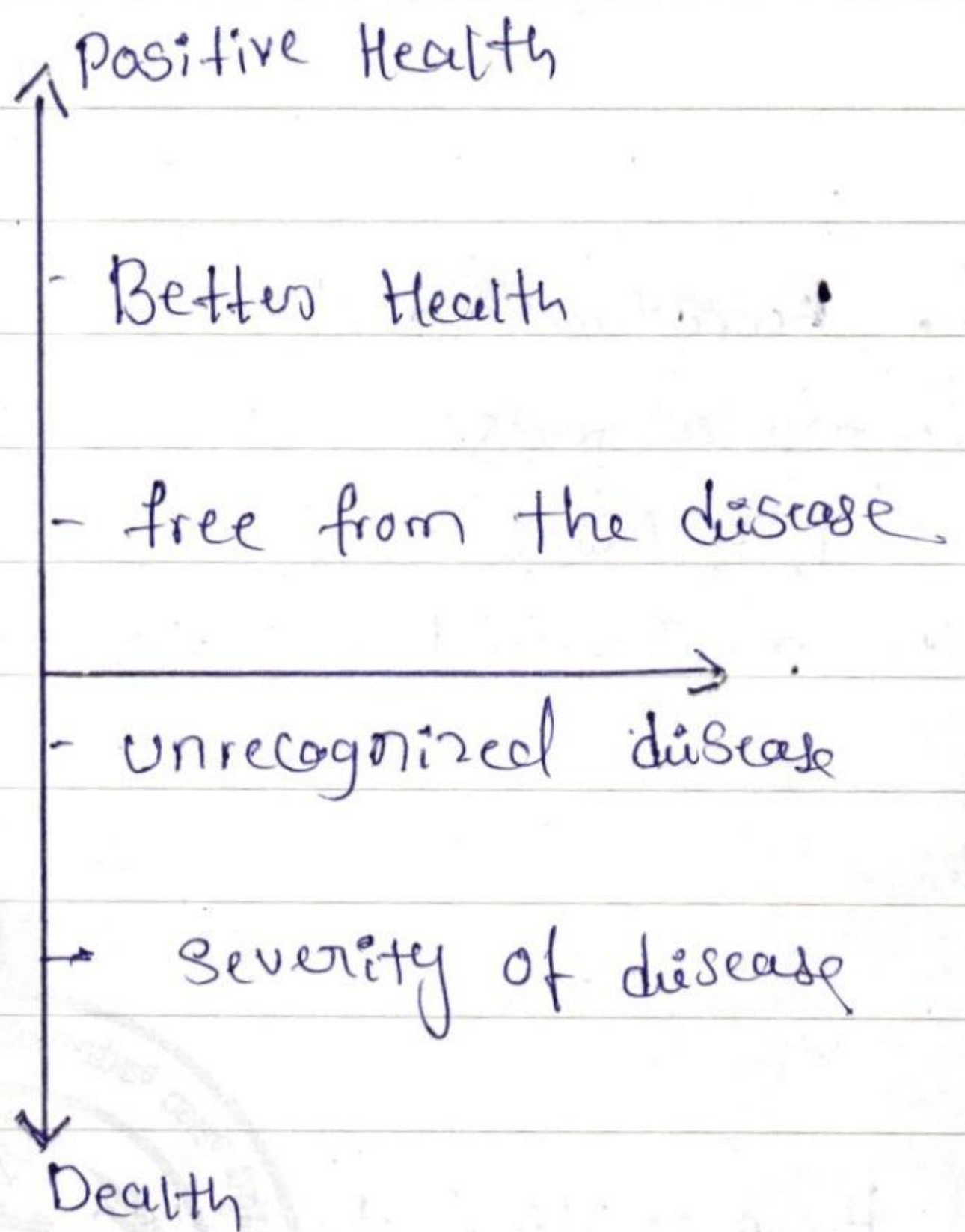

→ 1) primordial prevention :-

primordial prevention is taken to prevent from the risk factors which are already existing in the environment

→ To provide a healthy environment and a clean air and keep hygiene

→ For example lung cancer :-

* Eat dietary food

* Stop the consumption of alcohol

* Stop the Smoking.

* Exercise

→ This can prevent the risk factors.

Primary Health Care:-

In primary health care if a person having a disease or a person is well and not having any disease then it is called Primary Prevention

Ex:- Lung Cancer.

- * primary prevention we can go to hospital to make scans
- * Follow up the medication
- * Test the physical checkups.
- * follow the nutritional food list.
- * make Exercise
- * keep the environment clean and Hygiene

Secondary prevention:-

In secondary prevention if a person having a disease and the sign and symptoms are not shown in a person.

For example:- Lung Cancer.

- * if a person has a Lung Cancer but the sign and symptoms are not yet shown outside.

3) Thirsty prevention -

In Thirsty prevention a person have a disease and having sign and symptom and also gone for diagnosed and treatment

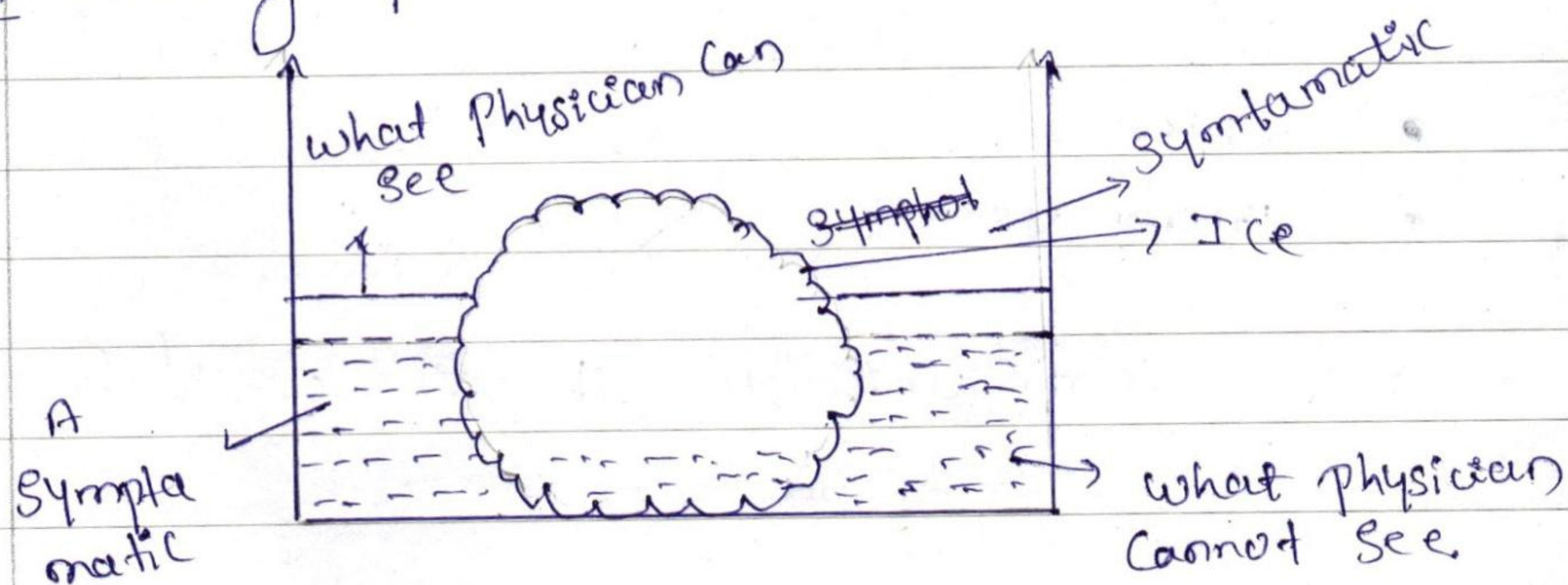
• In Thirsty a person is having sign and symptoms under gone diagnosis and treatment.

- Cancer ext.

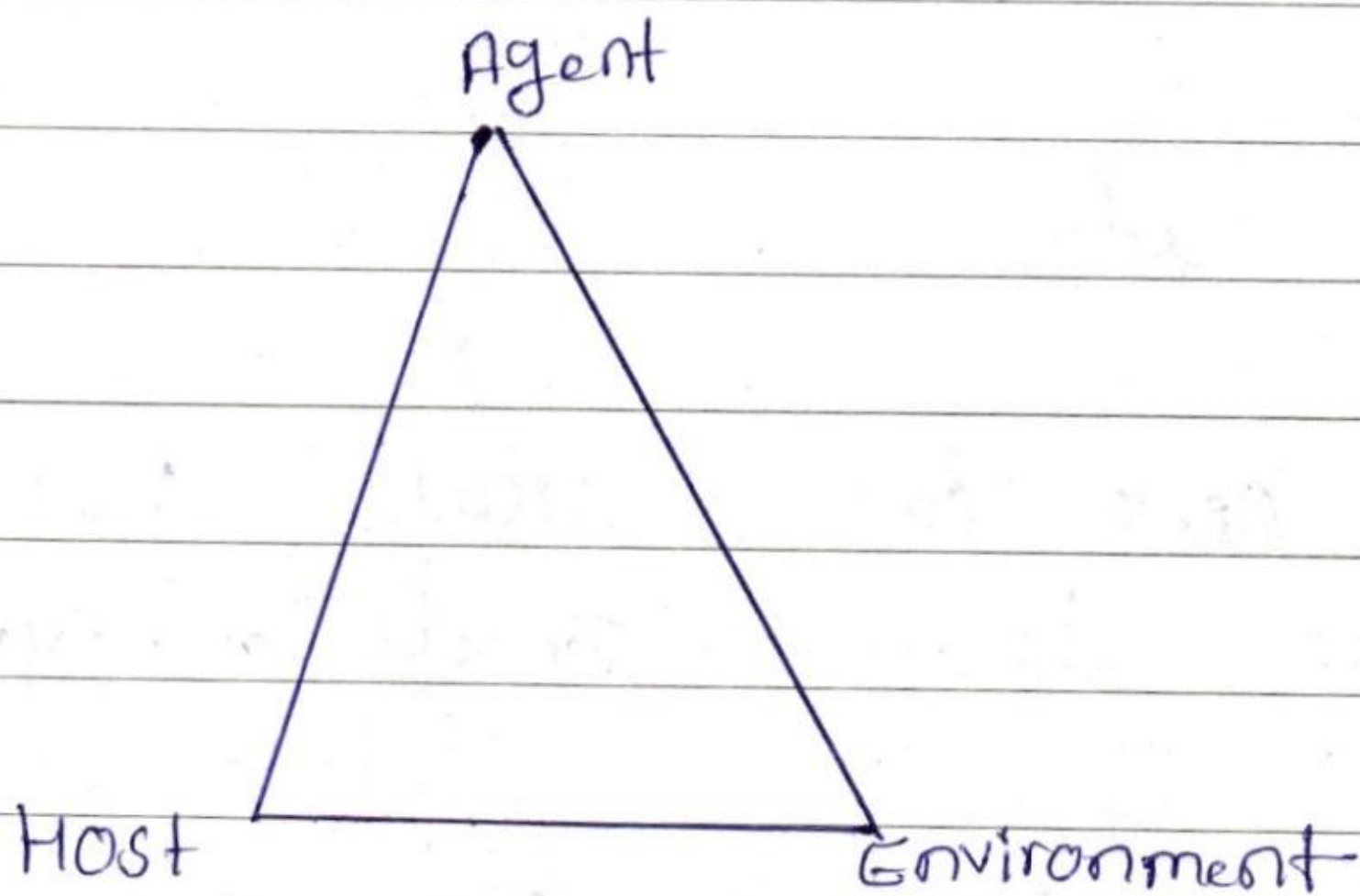
• The mid line can indicate both symptomatic disease and a symptomatic disease.

→ Epidemiological triad is defined as the relationship between the agent, host and environment is known as Epidemiological triad.

 - Environment

* Agent:- Cause of disease is known as agent.

- Biological agent
- physical agent
- chemical agent
- Environment agent

- Biomedical agent would be, viruses, fungi, bacteria, molds, These are the causative agent.
- physical agent :- It would be the air, heat and cold.
→ The agent would be from the cold and from heat and from the air.
- Chemical agent :- In chemical agent are many organic component also there would be microorganisms.
- Environmental agent :- Environmental agent would be the agent can enter by air, water, from environment from water we can get water born disease.
- Host :- Host would under the susceptible environment and man, and animals.
→ If the agent came through the environment and man would be the susceptible for the host.

+ In man if the agent come through the water or food the susceptible would the man will be the favourable environment for the agent to make breeding in the human body. The best example - the agent would be anopheline mosquito. It come to the favourable to the human by sucking or biting the human and it can give its spores in the blood so man will get the malarial disease.

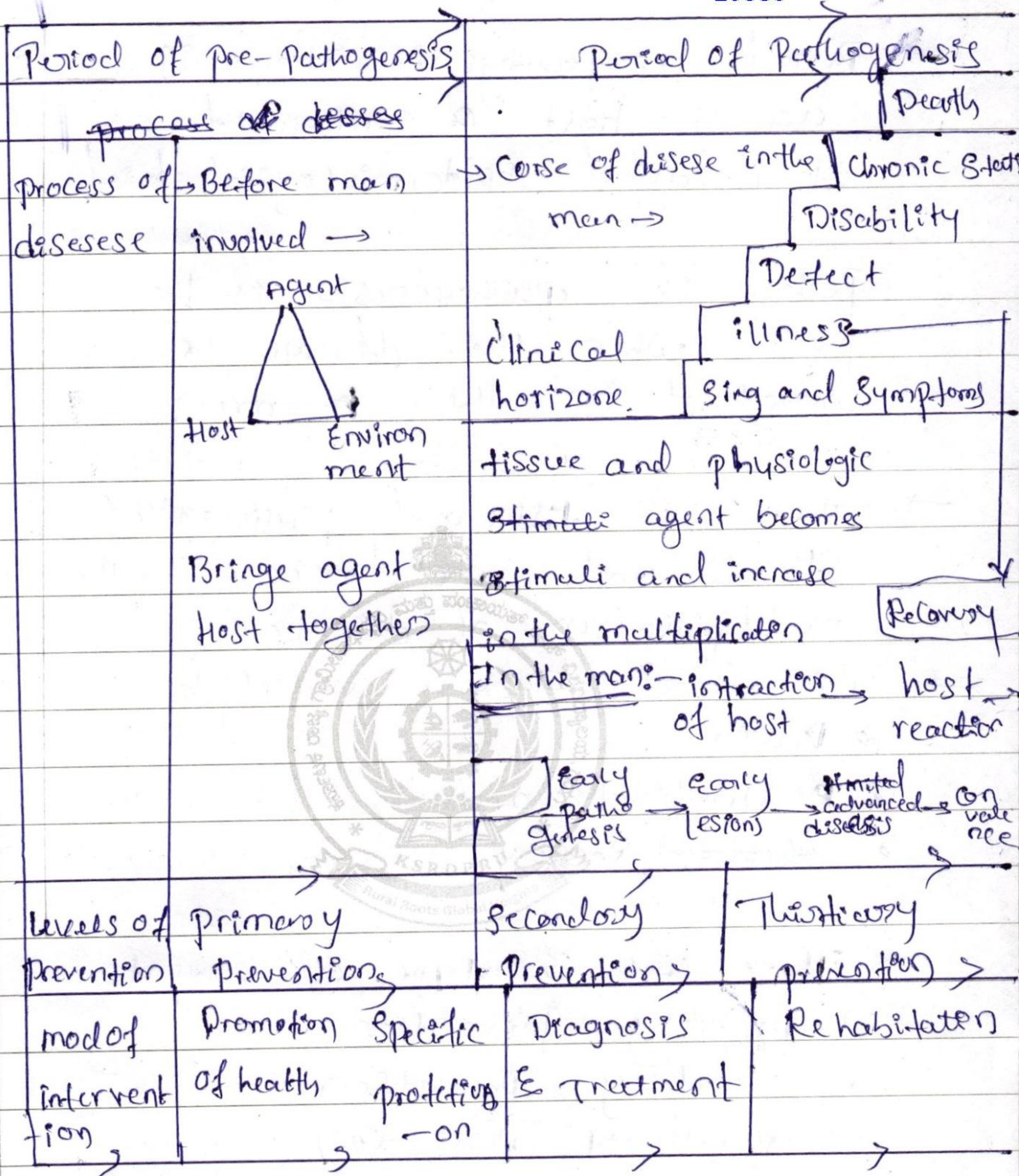

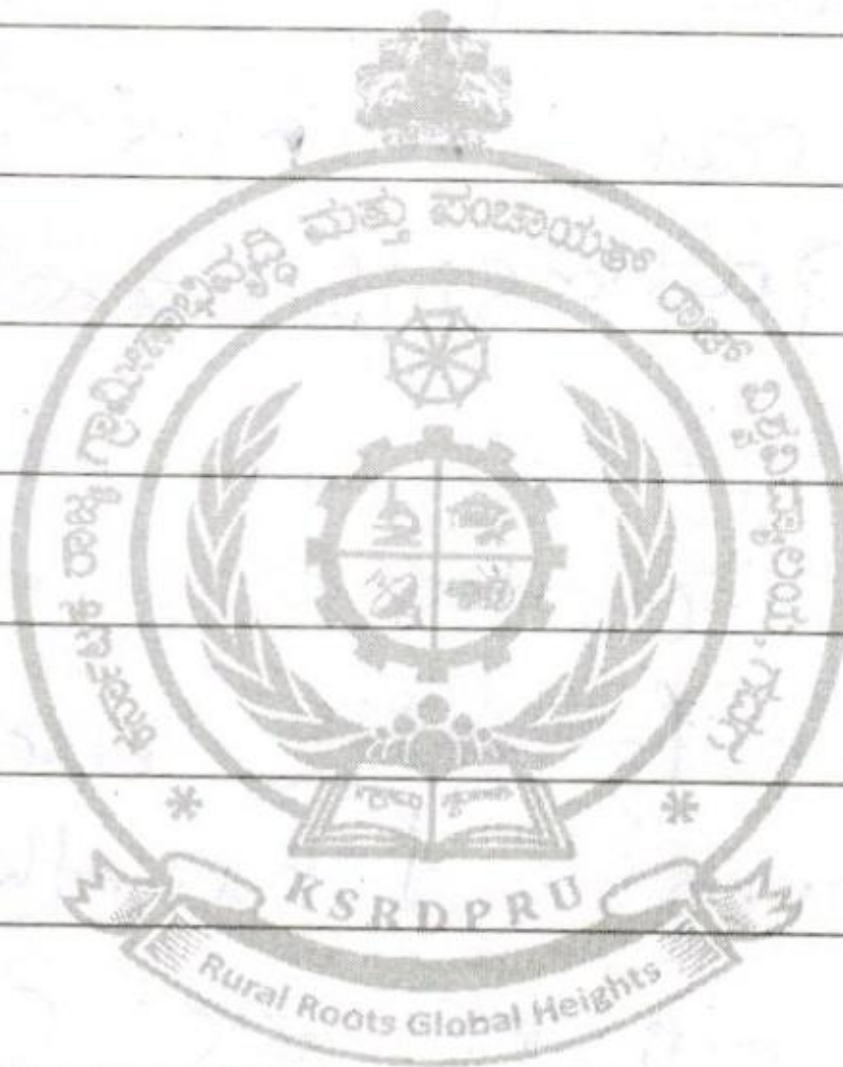

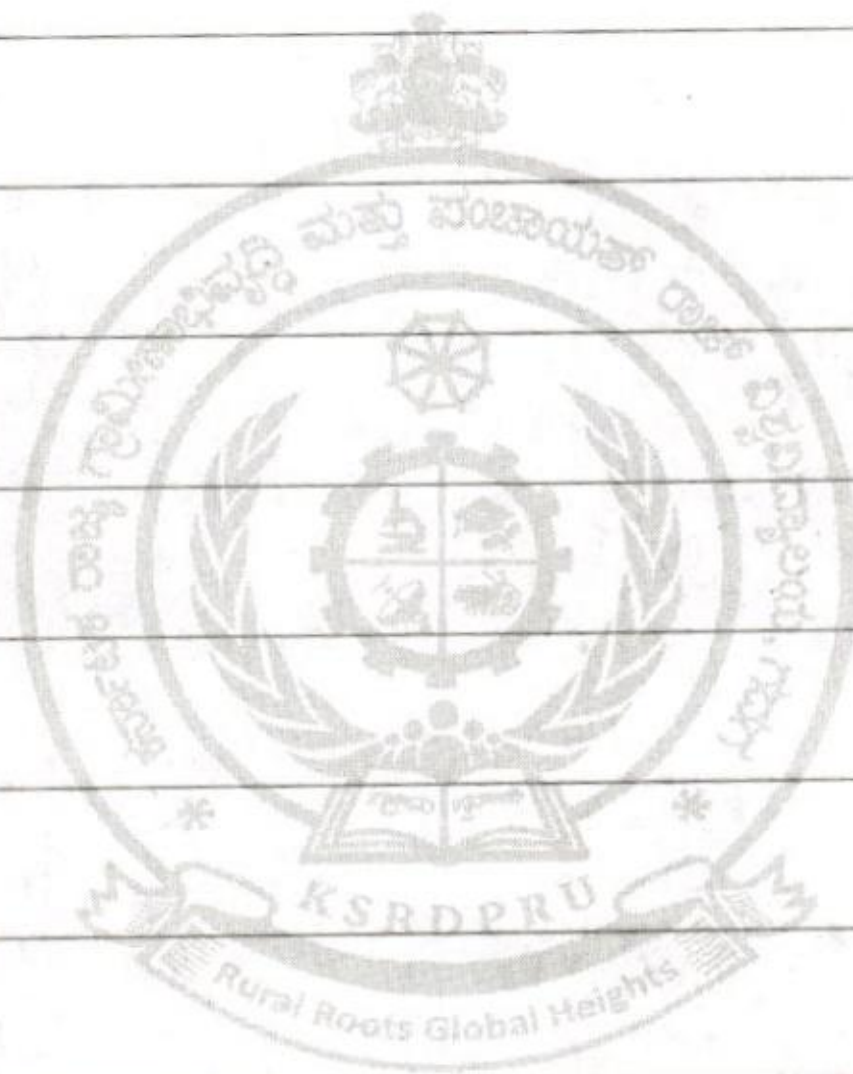
→ Biological means :- by the bacterial virus, parasites and flies

→ By these two types we can get the disease.

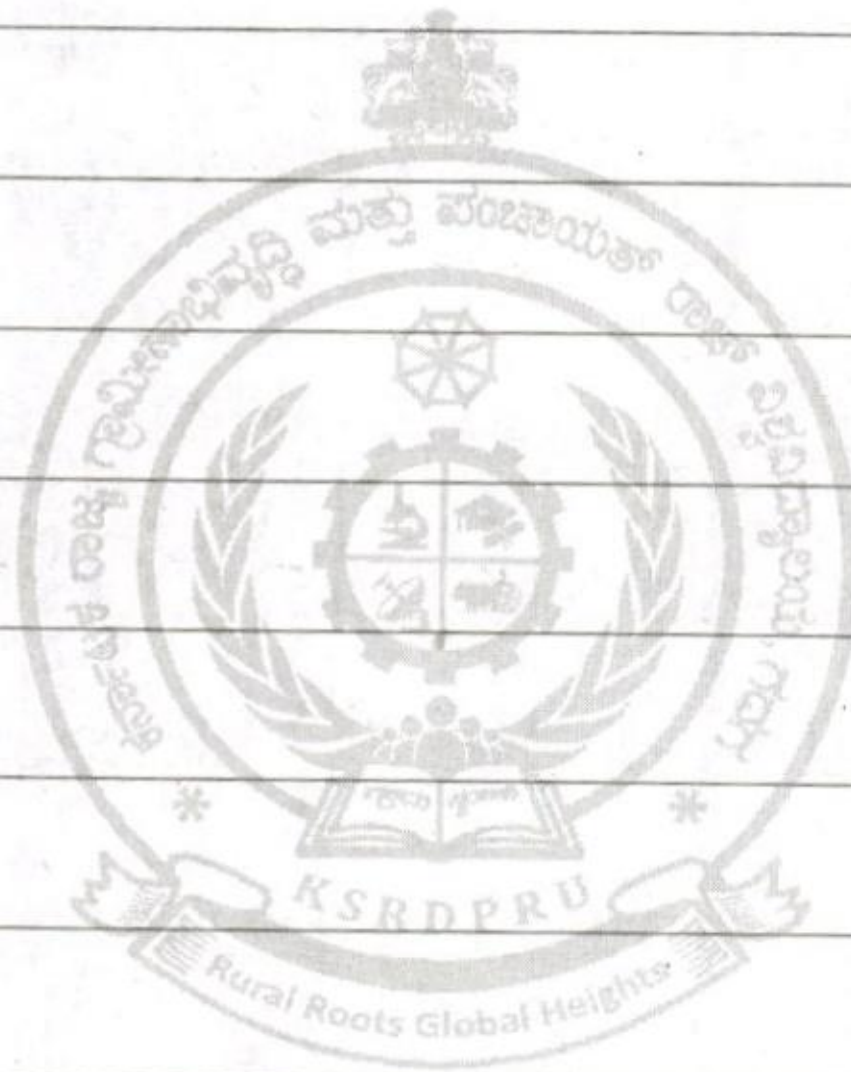

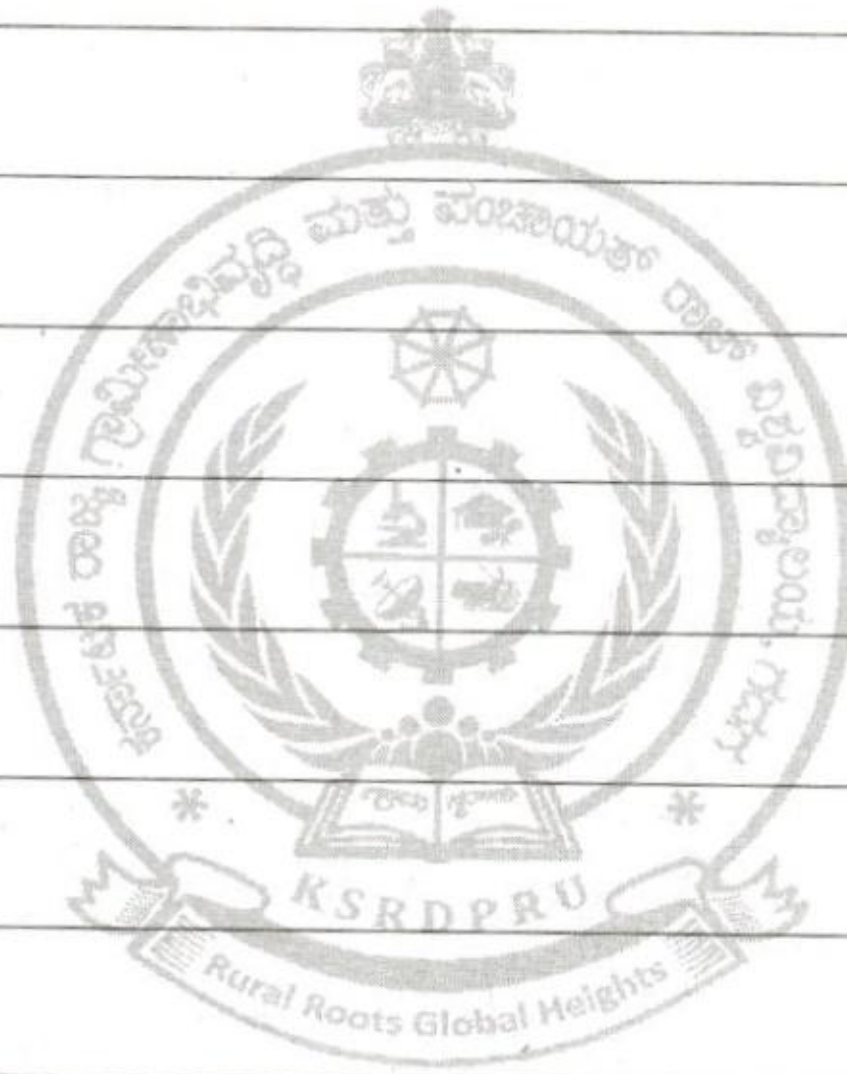






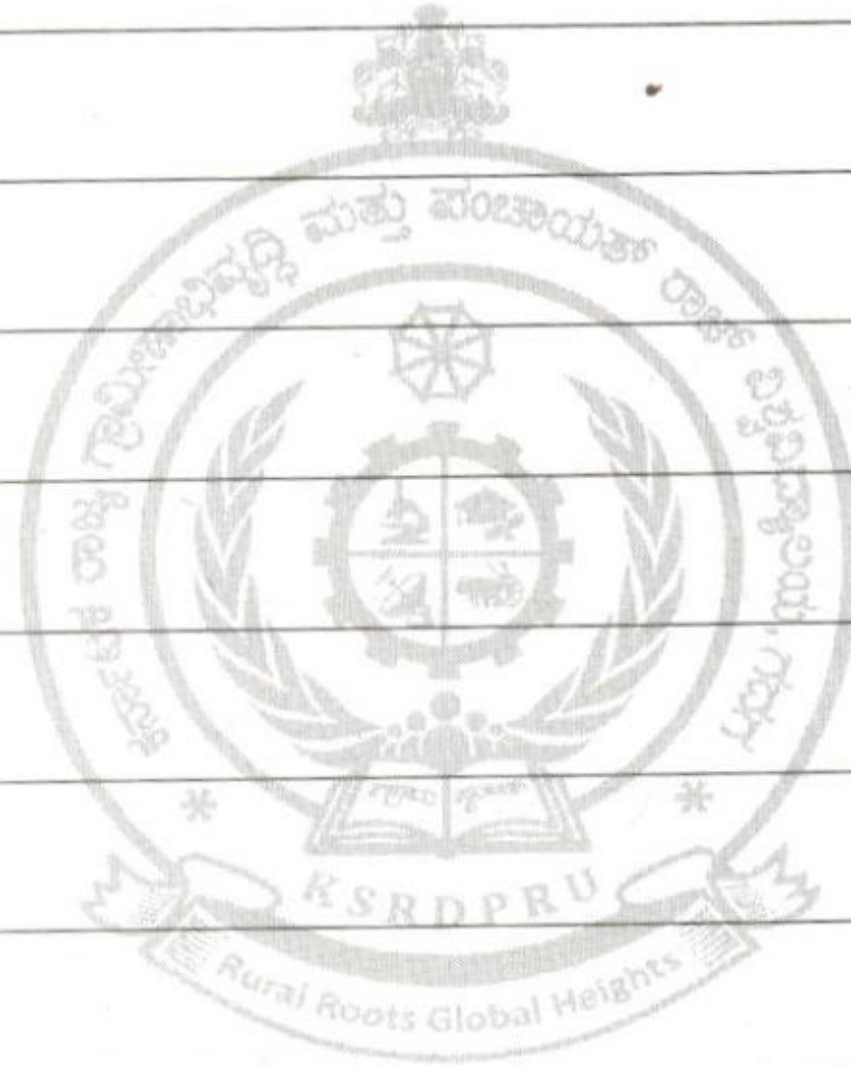
